 be so Recognize & because as well & of which said precept the said  
 Sherrif to wit John Groskam Gents now here at this Day to wit the  
 nineteenth day of March anno Dom one thousand Seven Hundred  
 and thirty four makes Return that he hath here ready twelve & as by  
 his precept he was Commanded and now hereafterwards to wit the Day and  
 year last mentioned come againe the aforesaid the Lord prop<sup>ty</sup> by his attorney  
 aforesaid and the aforesaid Mary Jones in her proper person and Jurors of that Jury  
 being Impannelled and Called Likewise came to wit Thomas Smith

 say ~~therefore~~ it is Considered by the Justices hereto wit at Kent County at  
 the Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday

 Seven Hundred and thirty three That the aforesaid Mary Jones as to the Indict-  
 ment aforesaid she go thereof without Day and it is also Considered by the Justices aforesaid
