All which said Court to wit at Kent County at the Court House in the Town of Chester in Said County on the third Tuesday in June then next ensuing Eighteenth day of Said Month Anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred and thirty four being the day of return of said writ came John Gresham Gentleman Sheriff of Kent County and made return thereof to the Court here ordered as follows by Cori Corpus J. In Gresham Sheriff

All now here at the said Court the said Elizabeth being called came and in her proper person appeared and was ordered to give Security for her appearance at next Eight Hours to wit into an Indulment of Fornication

upon which the said Elizabeth Macfield late of Kent County Spinstrix in her proper person in Court came and acknowledged herself indebted to the Right Hon. the Lord prop. in the sum of five pounds Sterling to be made and levied on her body goods and Chattles Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lord Ship his heirs and Successors conditionally that if she doth not make her personall appearance at the next Court to be held for said County on the third Tuesday in August then next ensuing to answer unto an Indulment for Committing Fornication &c and that she acknowledge herself

to be therewith content and also at the same time came Benjamin Gieand of Kent County planter in Court in his proper person came and acknowledged himself indebted to the right Honourable the Lord prop. in the sum of five pounds Sterling to be made and levied on his body goods and Chattles Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lord Ship his heirs and Successors conditionally that if the said Elizabeth Macfield shall not make her personall appearance at the next Court to be held for said County on the third Tuesday in August then next ensuing to answer unto an Indulment for Committing
