Also came John Cleave of Hert County plainer & present in Court in his proper person cometh & Acknowledges himself Indebted to the right Hon^{ble} Lord properly in the sum of ten pounds Sterling to be made & Levied on his body Goods & Chattels Lands & Tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs & Successors Conditionally if if Benj^r Cleave shall not appear & answer at next County Court to be held at our Court house in the town of Chesham in said County on the thirduesday in August next to answer unto what shall be Objected against him on his Lordships behalf on account of his Committing fornication with a Certain M^{rs} Evans & in y^e mean time he is to be of good behavior where with y^e same John Cleave Acknowledges himself to be Content —
