Morgan Hurl at the same Court aforesaid entered into Recognizance for the appearance of the aforesaid Patrick Clarke at this Court and to answer as aforesaid. This Court here discharges the same Recognizance there being no cause shown to the contrary.

Indictment of assault for assaulting William Graves the same Patrick appears to the same and the Court continues the Indictment to next August Court.

Ordered by this Court that the aforesaid Patrick Clarke enter into Recognizance for his appearance at next Court to be held for said County on the third Tuesday in August next with Sureties &c.

Patrick Clarke of Kent County Blacksmith and present in Court in his proper person cometh and acknowledges himself indebted to the Right Hon. the Lord Prop. in the Sum of Ten pounds Sterling to be made and Levied on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lord Ship his heirs and Successors conditionally that if he doth not make his personall appearance at the next Court to be held for Kent County on the third Tuesday in August next then and there to answer unto a certain Indictment found against him for assaulting a certain William Graves and in the meantime to be of good behav. wherewith he acknowledges himself to be content.

Also Isaac Hanson and Robert Green both of Kent County Planters and present in Court in their proper persons cometh and acknowledges themselves indebted to the Right Hon. the Lord Prop. in the Sum of Five pounds Sterling each to be made and Levied on their bodies goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lord Ship his heirs and Successors conditionally that if the aforesaid Patrick Clark shall not make his personall appearance at the next Court to be held for said County on the third Tuesday in August
