against same Peter on the assault &c. which Information is as follows

Kent County &c. Be it remembered that Touchet Francis Gent.  
attorney of the right Honourable the said Proprietary that now is who for the  
same Lord Proprietary in this part prosecuteth doth come here into the County  
Court of the same Lord Proprietary held for Kent County &c. to wit at Boston  
Town in the County &c. the nineteenth day of June Anno Domini Secon:  
teen hundred thirty and four before James Harris Esq. and his associates the  
said Lord Proprietary his Justices of the same County Court and for the same Lord  
Proprietary doth give the same Justices here to understand and be informed  
that Peter Green late of S. Pauls parish in the County of Kent the same  
nineteenth day of June Anno Domini Seventeen hundred thirty & four at the  
parish &c. in the County &c. within the Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon  
Edward Rogers jun. of the same County in the peace of God and of the same  
said Proprietary then and there being with force and Arms an assault did  
make and the same Edward then and there did beat wounds and evilly treat  
so that of his life it was greatly despaired and other harms to him then and  
there did to the great damage of the same Edward and against the peace of the  
said Lord Proprietary his good rule and Government &c. Wherefore the same  
Attorney of the said Lord Proprietary for the same Lord Proprietary prayeth  
the advice of the Court here in the premises and that due process of Law in  
this part against the said Peter may be made to answer unto the said Lord  
Proprietary of and upon the premises &c.
