ordered by this Court that John Gresham Sheriff of Mont County keep
 the aforesaid Peter Green in safe Custody until the Fine aforesaid shall be
 Satisfied

Ordered by this Court that the same Peter Green enter into Recognizance
 for his appearance at next Court and good behavior in the mean time
 and the aforesaid Peter Green of Mont County Planter present here in Court came
 in his proper person and acknowledged himself Indebted to the Right hon.
 the Lord proprietor in the Sum of ten pounds Sterling money of
 Great Brittain to be made and levied on his body goods and Chattels
 Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lord Ship his heirs and assigns
 conditionally that if he does not make his personal appearance at the
 next Court to be held for Mont County on the third Tuesday in August
 next and in the mean time he is to be of good behavior whereunto
 he acknowledges himself to be therewith content

and also Robert Green of Mont County Planter and present here in
 Court in his proper person came and acknowledged himself Indebted to the Right
 hon. the Lord proprietor in the Sum of ten pounds Sterling money of Great Brittain
 to be made and levied on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements
 to the use of his said Lord Ship his heirs and assigns conditionally that
 if the aforesaid Peter Green shall not appear at the next Court to be held for
 Mont County on the third Tuesday in August next and in the mean time he is to be
 of good behavior whereunto the same Robert Green acknowledges himself content
