Be it Remembred that on the sixth day of May Anno Domini one Thousand Seven hundred and thirty four came before me one of his Lordships Justices of the peace for Kent County Robert Green of Kent County Planter and Acknowledged himself indebted to the Right hon. the Lord prop^r in the sum of ten pounds Sterling to be made and Levied on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements conditionally that if Jane Green wife of the afo^r Robert shall not make her personall appearance at the next Court to be held for said County on the third Tuesday in June then next ensuing to answer unto what shall be objected against her on account of assaulting Elizabeth Dunmahoo and in the mean time she is to be of good behav^r wherewith the same Robert Green Acknowledges ~~himself~~ ^{himself} to be contented ~~with~~ ^{with} and now here at this Court to wit at Kent County at the Court house in the Town of Chichester in said County on the third Tuesday in June being the eighteenth day of said Month Anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred and thirty four came the afo^r Jane Green and in her proper person appeared and prayed her husbands Recognizance for her appearance may be discharged - The Court orders that the same Recognizance be discharged as prayed -

Robert Green his Recognizance taken as afo^r is by this Court here discharged there being no cause shown to the contrary.

All the same time afo^r Matthew Dunmahoo of Kent County Planter came before me one of his Lordships Justices of the peace for Kent County and Acknowledged himself indebted to the Right hon. the Lord prop^r in the sum of ten pounds Sterling to be made and Levied on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors conditionally that if his wife Elizabeth Dunmahoo shall not make her personall appearance at next Court to be held for Kent County at the Court House in the Town of Chichester in said County on the third Tuesday in June next ensuing then and there to give her Evidence on his Lordships behalf against Jane Green wherewith the said Matthew Dunmahoo Acknowledges himself contented -

And now here at Kent County at the Court House in the Town of Chichester in said County on the third Tuesday in June being the eighteenth day of said Month Anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred and thirty four came the afo^r Elizabeth Dunmahoo and appeared and prayed that her Husbands Recognizance for her appearance might be discharged
