ordered by this Court that the fine and be delivered the Sheriff of this County. after which John Gresham Gentleman Sheriff of said County comes and acknowledges the receipt of the same fine ordered by this Court that Surety be given for the said Thomas Albert and Daniel Dullaunt of Kent County planters present in Court in their proper person and acknowledge themselves indebted to the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietarie in the sum of Six hundred pounds of Tobacco to be levied on their bodies goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements conditionally That if the said David Kenlagh doth not pay the fees accruing on the premises and to the officers of this Court wherewith they acknowledge themselves to be therewith content.

His Lordship's Command was given on the Twentieth day of June Anno Domini one Thousand Seven hundred and thirty four in the Twentieth Year of His Lordship's Dominion. To the Sheriff of Kent County that he should take Joseph Nicholson late of St. Pauls parish in the County of Kent who should be found in his bailwicks and him safe keep so that he have his body before the Justices of our next County Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in August next ensuing to answer unto a certain Information with
