At which said third Tuesday in June being the eighteenth day of said month Anno Domini one Thousand Seven hundred and thirty four came the said Lord Proprietary by his attorney and the same Patrick in his proper person and the same Indulment was continued until the third Tuesday in August then next ensuing

At which said third Tuesday in August being the twentieth day of said month Anno Domini one Thousand Seven hundred and thirty four came again the said Lord Proprietary by his attorney and the same Patrick in his proper person and saith that notwithstanding his averment aforesaid. He cometh and saith that he cannot gain say the Indulment aforesaid as aforesaid against him brought nor can he say but that he is guilty of the premises aforesaid as by the Indulment it is alleged and thereupon submits to the Court. Therefore it is considered by the Justice here to wit the same day and year last mentioned.

That the same Patrick Clarke do find the sum of two Shillings and six pence current money as a fine for committing the aforesaid aforesaid and also pay the sum of one hundred and fourteen pounds of Tobacco costs accruing on the premises aforesaid to the officers of this Court ordered by this Court that find aforesaid do deliver the Sheriff of New County

thereupon the same Sheriff acknowledged the receipt thereof The same Patrick at said Court entered into Recognizance for his appearance at this Court to answer the aforesaid Indulment and in the meantime he was to be of good behaviour with two Sureties

The same Patrick Clarke at this Court appears and prays his Recognizance and his Sureties may be discharged Patrick Clarke his Recognizance taken aforesaid in the sum of ten pounds shoud be answer aforesaid. This Court here discharges the same Recognizance there being no cause shown to the contrary

At the same Court aforesaid Harrie Hanson and Robert Green entered into Recognizance in the sum of five pounds shoud each for the appearance of the aforesaid Patrick Clarke to answer aforesaid This Court here discharges the same Recognizances each of them their are here discharged there being no cause shown to the contrary
