Thereupon Daniel Perkins of Kent County Midwight and in his proper person acknowledged himself indebted to the right Honourable the Lord Proprietary in the sum of twenty pounds to be made and levied on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if the afd William Salisbury shall not make his personal appearance at the next Court to be hold for Kent County on the third Tuesday in November next ensuing and there to answer unto what shall be objected against him on his Lordships behalf on account of his wronging an estate on William David Crane and that in the mean time he is to be of good behavior wherewith he acknowledges himself Content
