 behaviour wherewith he acknowledges himself content At the same  
 time came George Garnott and William Davis both of Kent County  
 planters and acknowledged themselves indebted to his said Lordships  
 in the sum of ten pounds Sterling each to be made and levied on  
 their bodies goods and chattels Lands and Tenements conditionally that  
 if the said Thomas Martin should not make his personal appearance at  
 the then next court to be held for the said Kent County at the Court House  
 in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in August then  
 next ensuing to answer unto what should be objected against him on his Lord-  
 ships behalf for committing fornication with the said Joan Edwards and in  
 the mean time he is to be of good behaviour wherewith the same  
 George Garnott and William Davis acknowledge themselves content
