And the afo Thomas Martin in his proper person and said that he cannot gain say the Indenture as to as afo against him brought over but that he is guilty of the promises upon him imposed as by the afo Indenture. it is alleged And thereupon submits to the Court Therefore it is considered by the Court here at the Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on the third day in March being the eighteenth day of said Month Anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred and twenty eight That the afo Thomas Martin stand in the pillory for the space of half an hour. And that afterwards he receive at the public whipping post twenty one Lashes well laid on his bare back till the blood appear as a punishment for his afo Crime of committing felony as by the afo Indenture is set forth also it is considered that the said Thomas Martin pay forty Shillings Current money it being the full value of the four Gold of the Silver Spoon as afo Stolen the same being valued at Ten Shill. and that also the value of the said Spoon be also made good to the afo Mary Moll. And also pay the sum of two hundred and fifteen pounds of Tobacco lost accruing on the promises afo to the officers of this Court

It is also considered by the Court here at this day to wit the day and year last mentioned That the Sheriff of Kent County take the afo Thomas Martin into his custody and execute the punishment in the Judgment afo specified and afterwards to bring him into Court againe Of which precept the said Sheriff to wit John Gresham Esq. Sheriff of Kent County makes return on the day and year last said That he hath executed the said Judgment and also hath here the said Thomas Martin before the Court

The said W. William Nicholson being obliged to pay the four Gold afo amounting to forty Shillings Cur. money and also the value of the Spoon being ten Shillings which in the whole amounts to fifty Shill. Cur. money and two hundred and fifteen pounds of Tobacco lost afo for the afo Thomas Martin according to Act of Assembly in such Case lately made and provided w. for the space of one year at the expiration of his term of Service the said Thomas Martin shall serve his said Mast. W. William Nicholson or his assigns

The afo William Nicholson on the eight day July Anno Domini 1728/29 came into Recognition before M^r Geo Shurven one of his Maj. Ships Justices of Peace for said County in the sum of Ten pounds Sterl for the Appearance of the afo Thomas Martin at this Court. The said Thomas having appeared the said William Nicholson desired his Recognition for the afo Thomas might be discharged and willing appearing why it should not It is ordered that the same be discharged. This Court here discharged the same
