Therefore it is considered by the Court here on the third Tuesday in August being the Nineteenth day of said month Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and twenty nine at the Court House in the Town of Chester in said County. That the said Richard Foulston do find the sum of One Thousand pounds of Tobacco as a fine for his offence and according to the verdict of the Jurors sd. And also pay the sum of Three hundred Ninety three pounds of Tobacco for Damages on the premises to the Officers of this Court. And that Joseph Young Sheriff of said County keep the said Richard in safe Custody until the fine and Fees are paid and he shall satisfy

The sd Richard Foulston at last Term Court entered into Recognizance in the sum of twenty sd. for his appearance to this Court and now at this Court being the third Tuesday in August and the Nineteenth day of said month Anno Domini Seventeen hundred twenty and nine the time to which he was bound to appear. And now being in his proper person at Court and prayd that the same Recognizance might be discharged ordered by the Court here that the same Recognizance be discharged. no person showing any cause to the contrary. The same is by this Court here discharged

Dan. Ferrill being summoned as an Writ. in the same Cause shows three days Attendance ordered by the Court here that Richard Foulston pay him the sum of Ninety pounds of Tob. for the same

Joseph Butler being an Evidence in the same Cause shows three days Attendance ordered by the Court here that Richard Foulston pay him the sum of two hundred and Seventy pounds of Tobacco for the same
