the roosting or feeding grounds or waters of water-rail or ortolan or reed-birds, rail-birds or rice-birds. Any person violating the provisions of this paragraph shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine of not less than ten (\$10.00) dollars nor more than fifty (\$50.00) dollars for each offense.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1924.

CHAPTER 434.

An Act to repeal Chapter 166 of the Acts of 1860, entitled "An Act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from the west end of Uniontown, in Carrall County, to the completed terminus of the Westminster and Hagerstown turnpike road."

CHAPTER 435.
