proposed main, conduit, pipe or other structure, which plans must be approved by the Commission before such construction is begun, and when approved no change shall be made in the physical location of anything shown upon said plan except upon the approval of the Commission. Whenever any public service corporation, company or individual shall begin to put any such main, conduit, pipe or other structure in any such street, road, alley or public highway without first filing plans with the Commission and obtaining the approval thereof, as above specified, or shall, without the approval of the Commission, make any change in the location of such mains, conduits, pipes or other structures, as shown upon the plans approved by the Commission, or any approved change therein, such action shall constitute a misdemeanor, punishable as prescribed in Section 18 of this Act, and the Commission may, when any such main, conduit, pipe or other structure interferes with the construction or operation of its water or sewer systems or any of them, remove the same or change the location thereof.

- SEC. 12. And be it further enacted, That for the purpose of making extensions beyond the city limits of Salisbury, which right is hereby expressly conferred upon said Commission for water supply and sewerage from time to time as it may deem necessary, all charges and expenses therefor shall be under the jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission of Maryland, which is hereby authorized and directed to review upon application by said Commission the cost of making such extensions, and the findings of the Public Service Commission shall be final, except that there may be an appeal to the courts from such findings, as is provided by law in the case of other determinations by the Public Service Commission. The Commission is hereby empowered, authorized and directed to raise funds, as herein provided, for the expenditures authorized and directed by this section.
- SEC. 13. And be it further enacted, That said Commission, for the purpose of assessing benefits for the water supply and sewerage systems which may be acquired or constructed under this Act, shall divide all property binding upon a street, lane, alley or right of way in which the water pipe or sanitary sewer is to be laid into classes. Immediately upon the purchase or condemnation or construction of the water supply or sewerage system, the Commission is empowered to fix and levy a benefit charge upon all property abutting upon the water mains or sewers in accordance with the classification.
