To the sale, grant and conveyance in fee to St. Matthews Evangelical Lutheran Congregation of Princess Anne, Maryland, a religious corporation duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Maryland from William J. Phillips and wife and Mary Johnson of certain real estate lying and being in West Princess Anne Election District, Somerset County, Maryland, dated the 30th day of December, 1916, recorded among the land records of said County in Liber W. J. S. No. 71, folio 453, etc.

66. To the bequest of Miss Priscilla Jones to the Poolesville Church of St. Peter's Parish \$4,840.80, one-half of income of said amount to be used for Rector's salary, and other half for expenses of the Church.
