

a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all of the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 568.

AN ACT to add one new section to Article 1A of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, title "Allegany County," sub-title "City of Cumberland," known as the Charter of the City of Cumberland, said new section to be known as Section 46A.

CHAPTER 569.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the Mayor and City Council of the City of Havre de Grace, State of Maryland, to issue bonds on the faith and credit of said City, in an amount as in the judgment of the said Mayor and City Council shall be necessary and expedient, not to exceed the sum of three hundred thousand (\$300,000.00) dollars, the proceeds thereof to be used in the purchase, erection, maintenance and construction of an Electric Light and Power Plant, transmission and distribution system, after having first submitted the question to and having received the approval of a majority of the qualified voters of said City voting on the question at said election.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted and ordained by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That whenever the Mayor and City Council of the City of Havre de Grace, State of Maryland, shall determine that it is advantageous for the City's interest to purchase or erect an Electric Light and Power Plant, transmission and distribution system, for the purpose of supplying electricity for municipal needs and to the inhabitants of said City and vicinity for domestic and other purposes or uses, having first obtained the approval and consent of the majority of the legally qualified voters of said City voting on the question, they are hereby authorized and empowered to borrow on the faith and credit of said City, an amount necessary in their judgment, to purchase or erect an Electric Light and Power Plant, transmission and distribution system, for said City, and
