

gaged by the said Magistrate, to perform such other duties as may be required by him of the Sheriff. The Mayor and City Council of Cumberland shall designate one or more members of the police force to attend such Magistrate and execute his process, orders and direction within the corporate limits of the City of Cumberland.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law and necessary for the preservation of public safety and being passed on a Yea and Nay vote, supported by three-fifths of all members elected to each of the two houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the day of its passage.

CHAPTER 78.

AN ACT to repeal Section 288 of Chapter 680 of the laws of Maryland, 1916, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 288 of Chapter 680 of the laws of Maryland, 1916, be, and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Section 288. On the third and fourth Mondays and Tuesdays in April, and on the first Monday and Tuesday in May in the year nineteen hundred and two, the City Clerk shall sit at the Council Chamber between the hours of nine o'clock A. M. and seven o'clock P. M. for the purpose of a new and general registration of the legally qualified voters of the City of Havre de Grace. And likewise thereafter on the second Monday and Tuesday in April of each year in which a municipal election is to be held the said City Clerk shall likewise sit during the same hours as officer of registration for said City for the purpose of registering the legally qualified voters of said City.

It shall be the duty of said Clerk to enter in alphabetical order upon the registry book the name of every person appearing before him at the times above specified, and requesting to be registered; provided he shall be satisfied by the oath of said person, or otherwise, that he is a citizen of the United States above the age of twenty-one years and has the property and other qualifications required by this Act for voters of said
