

CHAPTER 195.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 26A of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "St. Mary's County," sub-title "County Commissioners," as said section was amended by Chapter 337 of the Acts of 1922, increasing the compensation of the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 26A of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "St. Mary's County," sub-title "County Commissioners," as said section was amended by Chapter 337 of the Acts of 1922, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, to read as follows:

26A. The County Commissioners of St. Mary's County shall receive a salary of five hundred (\$500) dollars per year each, including mileage.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1924.

CHAPTER 196.

AN ACT to authorize the Police Commissioner of Baltimore City to pay a pension to Martin B. Gallagher, a former member of the Police Department of said city.

CHAPTER 197.

AN ACT to authorize the Police Commissioner of Baltimore City to pay a pension to William A. Cole.

(Vetoed.)

CHAPTER 198.

AN ACT to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to pay a pension to Patrick F. Moriarty, a former member of the Fire Department of said city.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore be and they are hereby authorized to pay a pension to Patrick F.
