

CHAPTER 255.

AN ACT to exempt from county and municipal taxation the musical instruments of the Frostburg City Band, Incorporated.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the musical instruments of the Frostburg City Band, Incorporated, shall be exempt from all county and municipal taxation.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1924.

CHAPTER 256.

AN ACT to authorize the Police Commissioner of Baltimore City to reinstate Frank Wolle as a member of the Baltimore Police Department.

WHEREAS, Frank Wolle was appointed a member of the Police Department of Baltimore City on December 7, 1914; and

WHEREAS, The said Frank Wolle resigned voluntarily from the said Police Department on October 16, 1917; and

WHEREAS, The said Frank Wolle desires to be reinstated in the said Police Department of Baltimore City, but because of age he is ineligible for reinstatement under the present laws governing the appointment of members of the Police Department of Baltimore City; therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Police Commissioner of Baltimore City be and he is hereby authorized and empowered, in his discretion, to reinstate Frank Wolle, of Elkridge, Maryland, as a member of the Police Department of Baltimore City in the same grade occupied by him at the time of his resignation therefrom.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1924.
