SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 1 of Chapter 169 of the Acts of 1922 be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

For the purposes of this Act the village of Alta Vista, Montgomery County, Maryland, as hereinafter described, shall constitute a special tax area or district and shall be deemed and taken to comprise all parcels of land embraced in the following described portions of the village of Alta Vista: Beginning for same at the intersection of the north side of Cedar Avenue with the western edge of Cypress Avenue as laid down on a plat of Alta Vista of record in Plat Book No. 2, Plat 107, one of the land records of Montgomery County, and running thence with the west side of Cypress Avenue N 3°38 W 418 feet to point of a curve to the left, having a radius of 309.3 feet for a distance of 576 feet more or less, to a point on the south side of Acacia Avenue as laid down on said plat, then with the south side of said Avenue S 66°22 W 490 feet more or less to the intersection of the wests ide of Linden Avenue extended thence with the west side of said Avenue and crossing over Maple Avenue N 20°47 W to the point on Linden Avenue which is the northeastern corner of the lands now owned by Henry R.
