21. To the bequest of the residue of his property to the Laurel Presbyterian Church, contained in the last will and testament of Horace B. To the deed and conveyance from the Central Presbyterian Church of Baltimore City to the Ridgely Street Presbyterian Church of said City, of the lot or parcel of ground, with the improvements thereon, at the northeast corner of Ridgely and Hamburg Streets, said deed being dated January 5th, 1927, and recorded among the land records of Baltimore City in Liber S.
