

CHAPTER 547.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 105-A of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "St. Mary's County," sub-title "Sheriff," as said section was enacted by Chapter 462 of the Acts of 1920, increasing certain fees of the Sheriff.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 105-A of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "St. Mary's County," sub-title "Sheriff," as said section was enacted by Chapter 462 of the Acts of 1920, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, to read as follows:

105-A. The Sheriff of St. Mary's County shall be allowed two dollars and fifty cents for serving a warrant and making arrest and one dollar for serving summons and return.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1927.

CHAPTER 548.

AN ACT to authorize the Police Commissioner of Baltimore to reinstate Frank Andrews as a member of the Baltimore Police Department and to reinstate Albert Dix as a member of the police force of Baltimore City.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with an amendment Section 328-A of Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Washington County," sub-title "Orphans' Court," as enacted by Chapter 38 of the Acts of 1924.
