

the County Commissioners, or within such longer period as is specified in said notice by said County Commissioners, shall be subject to a penalty of ten dollars, the said penalty to be collected as other fines and penalties are collected. Provided, however, that the County Commissioners, in their discretion, shall have the authority and power, after due notice, to have the trees, bushes, vines, fences or other obstructions removed and charge the cost of such removal to the owner or owners of the property, and such cost or charges shall become a lien on said property and may be collected in the same manner as taxes are collected.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1927.

CHAPTER 619.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 103 of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Revenue and Taxes."

CHAPTER 620.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 251, 252, 253 and 255 of Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Edition of 1924, title "Licenses," sub-title "Public Passenger Motor Vehicles," to revise the annual charges for registration; to subject to the provisions of said sub-title all motor vehicles operating for hire on regular schedules or between fixed termini, with certain exceptions; to revise the regulations relating to schedules and routes, and to add a new Section to said Article and sub-title, to be known as Section 257-A, and to follow immediately after Section 257, so as to make the several provisions of said sub-title independent and severable.
