rules and regulations for the administration and enforcement of this Act.

- SEC. 29. And be it further enacted, That nothing in this Act contained shall be deemed or construed to authorize the condemnation of any property in Anne Arundel County owned, controlled by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, or the County Commissioners of Baltimore County.
- SEC. 30. And be it further enacted, That when said Commission files their budget with the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel County, the said County Commissioners shall have the power to amend, alter or reduce said budget in their discretion.
- SEC. 31. And be it further enacted, That nothing in this of Act inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, be, and Election District of Anne Arundel County.
- SEC. 32. And be it further enacted, That all Acts and parts of Acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, be, and the same are hereby, repealed to the extent of their inconsistency; provided that nothing herein contained shall be taken as restricting any control which the State Board of Health of Maryland is empowered to exercise within the Sanitary Districts, and nothing in this Act shall apply to the City of Annapolis.
- SEC. 33. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1st, 1927.
