The above levies making an aggregate levy for State taxes of twenty-five and sixty-four one-hundredths cents (25.64c) for the year nineteen hundred and twenty-eight (1928), and of twenty-five and seventy-four one-hundredths cents (25.74c) for the year nineteen hundred and twenty-nine (1929) on each one hundred dollars (\$100) of assessable property.

And there shall be duly levied, in accordance with law, the same State taxes on the shares of the capital stock of all banks, State and National, and other incorporated institutions and companies of this State, the shares of whose capital stock are liable to assessment and taxation.
