Vehicles shall make a charge of One Dollar (\$1.00) for such transfer. In addition to the one-fifth of the net tax produced, less refund exemption, by the additional tax provided by this Act, the Comptroller shall pay to the State Roads Commission, monthly, out of the "Lateral Road Gasoline Tax Fund," one-half of a cent for each gallon of motor vehicle fuel for which the refund provided by this section has been claimed and paid during the preceding month, such monies to be utilized for the construction and maintenance of the streets and highways of the City of Baltimore or of such other incorporated city or town as aforesaid.

- 212-D. All Acts or parts of Acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed.
- 212-E. If any part or parts of this Act, or of any Section thereof, shall be held to be unconstitutional, such unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Act, or of any Section thereof, and the Legislature hereby declares that it would have passed the remaining parts of this Act or of any section thereof, if it had known that such part or parts thereof, or of any Section thereof, would be declared unconstitutional.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act is an emergency law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and having been passed by a yea and nay vote by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 119.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 91 of Article 72 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Oysters," sub-title "Packing Oysters"; and to add a new section to Article 72 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Oysters," sub-title "Packing Oysters," to be known as Section 91-A to follow immediately after Section 91 of said Article.
