Section 2. And be it further enacted, That all laws or parts of laws of the State of Maryland, general or local, inconsistent with the provisions of this Act be, and the same are hereby repealed, to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1st, 1927.

CHAPTER 126.

AN ACT to repeal Sections 62, 63, 64, 65, 66, 67, 68, 69 and 70 of Article 72 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Oysters," sub-title "Potomac."

Whereas Sections 71, 72, 73, 74, 75, 76, 77, 78 and 79 of Article 72 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Oysters," sub-title "Potomac," provide for concurrent legislation for the Potomac River between the States of Maryland and Virginia as to fish, oysters and crabs, under the terms of the compact of 1785 between the two States, and repeal all laws in conflict therewith; and

Whereas Sections 62, 63, 64, 65, 66, 67, 68, 69 and 70 of Article 72 are superseded by the concurrent acts, therefore;

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 62, 63, 64, 65, 66, 67, 68, 69 and 70 of Article 72 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Oysters," sub-title "Potomac," be and are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this act shall take effect June 1st, 1927.

CHAPTER 127.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Sections 2, 5 as same was re-enacted by Chapter 564 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland for the 1924, 6, 7, 27, 33, 34 and 81 of Article 72 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Oysters."
