

ballots shall be immediately cancelled by the Judges by endorsing thereon the word "Cancelled."

SEC. 4. *And be it further enacted*, That Section 18 of the said Act be and is hereby amended by striking out the words "Town Treasurer" and inserting in place thereof the words "Town Clerk," so as to conform to the provisions of Section 9 of this Act, and so that Section 18, as amended, shall read:

Section 18. *And be it further enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the Town Clerk, as soon as the annual tax levy is made and placed in his hands for collection, to give notice by advertisement in one newspaper published in the County and proceed to the collection of taxes through the town of Brentwood in compliance with the laws for collection of State and County taxes in Prince George's County.

SEC. 5. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and having been passed upon a yea and nay vote, supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 178.

AN ACT to incorporate the town of Colmar Manor, in Prince George's County, Maryland, to provide for the government thereof, and to provide for the submission of this question to the qualified voters of said town for their adoption or rejection.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the citizens of the town of Colmar Manor as hereinafter defined are a body corporate, by the name of the Mayor and Town Council of Colmar Manor, Maryland, and by that name may have perpetual succession, sue and be sued, have and use a common seal, and may purchase and hold all kinds of property including real estate, or dispose of the same by sale or lease for the benefit of said district.
