SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That all laws or parts of laws, general or local, inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency and all processes heretofore issued or hereafter issued which might be returnable to the first Monday of September shall be considered returnable to the third Monday of September.

Sec. 3. And be it further enacted, That this act shall take effect on June 1st, 1927.

CHAPTER 217.

AN ACT to repeal Section 37-A of Chapter 682, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session of 1908, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 37A of Chapter 682, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland passed at the January Session 1908, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with Amendments so as to read as follows:

37A. In addition to the first day of each term of the Circuit Court for said County, the first Monday in February, the second Monday in April, the third Monday in July and the first Monday in November of each year shall be return days for the return of processes in civil cases.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1st, 1927.
