

vide for the payment of the money borrowed and the interest thereon; in three payments, the first payment to be for ten thousand dollars with accrued interest and to be made in the year 1927; the second payment to be for ten thousand dollars with accrued interest and to be made in the year 1928; and the third payment to be for twelve thousand dollars with accrued interest and to be made in the year 1929, and to levy and collect all necessary taxes for said payments in the years above specified, namely, 1927, 1928 and 1929, respectively.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act is hereby declared to be an Emergency Law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and being passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three fifths of the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.
