

## CHAPTER 32.

AN ACT to repeal Sections 65-A, 65-B, 65-C and 65-D of Article 2 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "Annapolis," and to provide for the refund of monies paid in to Pension Fund as set out in said Section 65-D.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 65-A, 65-B, 65-C and 65-D of Article 2 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "Annapolis," be and the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That all money contributed toward the Police Pension Fund provided for by said Section 65-D be refunded by the Collector and Treasurer of The Mayor, Counselor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted,* That the Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and having been passed by a yea and nay vote, supported by three-fifths of all members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 33.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendment, Section 8 of Chapter 412 of the Acts of 1910, entitled "An Act to provide for the franchise of water works for the Town of Chestertown," to make water rent charges a lien on the properties furnished water.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 8 of Chapter 412 of the Acts of 1910 be, and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendment to read as follows:
