## CHAPTER 32.

AN ACT to repeal Sections 65-A, 65-B, 65-C and 65-D of Article 2 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "Annapolis," and to provide for the refund of monies paid in to Pension Fund as set out in said Section 65-D.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 65-A, 65-B, 65-C and 65-D of Article 2 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "Annapolis," be and the same are hereby repealed.

- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That all money contributed toward the Police Pension Fund provided for by said Section 65-D be refunded by the Collector and Treasurer of The Mayor, Counselor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis.
- SEC. 3. And be it further enacted, That the Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and having been passed by a yea and nay vote, supported by three-fifths of all members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 33.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendment, Section 8 of Chapter 412 of the Acts of 1910, entitled "An Act to provide for the franchise of water works for the Town of Chestertown," to make water rent charges a lien on the properties furnished water.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 8 of Chapter 412 of the Acts of 1910 be, and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendment to read as follows:
