To Spring Grove State Hospital, for enlarging and strengthening criminal insane building, \$30,000; equipment for Foster Clinic addition, \$10,000; and for boiler, power plant, laundry, machinery and water supply, \$20,000, aggregating \$60,000, all from the issue of August 15, 1927.

To the State Board of Welfare, for engine, generator, tunnelling wires and mechanical equipment at Maryland Penitentiary, \$31,000, from the issue of August 15, 1927, and at the House of Correction for new building and tiers, \$667,000; additional cells for women and relocating wire shop, \$50,000; power plant and mechanical equipment, \$82,000; and Warden's residence, \$20,000, aggregating at the House of Correction, \$819,000, of which \$594,000 shall be from the issue of August 15, 1927, and \$225,000 from the issue of February 15, 1928.
