

amount to be furnished by each of said counties is hereby made mandatory upon the proper authorities of the respective counties and subject to enforcement by mandamus at the instance of the State Roads Commission. Full power and authority is hereby granted to the County Commissioners or other lawfully constituted authorities of each and every county to raise said money in any of the ways hereinbefore set out, and in case they decide to raise the same by borrowing upon the credit and faith of the county, they are authorized to issue the bonds or certificates of indebtedness of said county to the extent of the amount so needed, upon such terms and conditions and with such rate of interest, and with such dates of maturity as to them may seem best. The Lateral road money raised by each and every county as hereinbefore provided shall be paid to the State Roads Commission at such times and in such amounts, and under such guarantees as the State Roads Commission shall from time to time determine. If the County Commissioners of any county shall have fixed the county tax levy for such county for the year 1927 prior to May 1, 1927, and said Board of Commissioners shall desire to raise the whole or any part of such county's share of said lateral road money for the year 1927 by assessing a tax upon the taxable basis of said county, the said Board of County Commissioners are hereby authorized and empowered to borrow such amount as shall be required for said purpose for the year 1927, and issue their script as evidence of the obligation, and to include in the next succeeding tax levy the amount necessary to repay such loan or loans.

SEC. 8. *And be it further enacted*, That one-half of the cost of construction of all lateral roads which shall be built in pursuance of the provisions of this Act, shall be paid by the State out of the proceeds from the sale of bonds set apart in the manner hereinbefore provided, to the counties in which such roads are respectively located, and the remaining one-half with the funds to be provided by said counties, respectively, as herein directed.

SEC. 9. *And be it further enacted*, That those portions of the proceeds from the sale of the bonds or certificates of indebtedness herein authorized, which are herein appropriated to meet obligations imposed upon the State by its assent to any Act or Acts of Congress appropriating Federal aid to the several States in the construction of rural post roads, shall be
