F: The full name and address of the person, firm or corporation assuming the responsibility, under the conditions of this sub-title, for the information placed on the tags or labels as required by this Section.

123. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to sell, offer or expose for sale within this State any agricultural seeds, or mixtures of agricultural seeds, as defined in this sub-title, for seeding purposes within this State without complying with the requirements of this sub-title, or falsely to mark, label or misrepresent any agricultural seeds, or to interfere in any way with the State Board of Agriculture or its inspectors or assistants in the discharge of the duties herein named.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1927.

CHAPTER 461.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Sections 2 and 3 of Chapter 254 of the Acts of 1922, increasing the salary of the Official Court Stenographer of Washington County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 2 and 3 of Chapter 254 of the Acts of 1922, be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, to read as follows:

2. The Judges of the Fourth Judicial Circuit of Maryland, be and they are hereby authorized and directed to appoint two Official Court Stenographers, one for the Circuit Court for Washington County, and one for the Circuit Court for Allegany and Garrett Counties, who shall be sworn officers of the courts of said circuit. And the said Court Stenographer so appointed for the Circuit Court for Washington County shall receive a salary of \$1,200.00 per annum.
