

dates for Commissioner, not less than six days preceding the date set for election, and have the same published in at least one newspaper in Talbot County not less than six days preceding said election, such names shall be grouped and arranged alphabetically according to surname. The ballot shall be of white paper not exceeding five inches in width and of sufficient length to accommodate the names of the candidates, and said ballot shall be voted by the voter drawing a black line through the names not voted for. If at any election there be any question to be submitted to the voters, said question shall be placed upon the ballot in full followed by a line "For proposition" and a line "Against proposition" and the voter shall strike out with a black line whichever proposition he is against.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety and health, and being passed upon a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of passage.

## CHAPTER 470.

AN ACT to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to issue certificates of indebtedness of said corporation to an amount not exceeding ten million dollars (\$10,000,000), for the purpose of defraying the cost and expenses of the acquisition of school house sites and the construction of school buildings; additions, improvements, and re-construction of existing school buildings; authorizing the submission of an ordinance for that purpose to the legal voters of the City of Baltimore; empowering the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to provide by ordinance for the expenditure of the proceeds of said loan; providing for the method of expenditure, and declaring this act an emergency law.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore be, and it is hereby authorized to issue the certificates of indebtedness of said corporation to an amount not exceeding ten million dollars (\$10,000,000), said certificates of indebtedness to be issued from
