

CHAPTER 387.

AN ACT to authorize the State Roads Commission of Maryland to join with the State Highway Commission of Virginia, to purchase the interstate highway bridge and approaches over the Potomac River near Point of Rocks, Maryland, and to use funds appropriated for the construction of roads and bridges in the State highway system for such purpose, to provide for the vesting of title to said bridge and approaches jointly in the State of Maryland and the Commonwealth of Virginia, in each an undivided one-half interest; to authorize the State Roads Commission of Maryland and the Board of Supervisors of Loudoun County, Virginia, to purchase the interstate highway bridge and approaches over the Potomac River at Brunswick, Maryland, and the vesting of title to said bridge and approaches jointly in the State of Maryland and the Board of Supervisors of Loudoun County, in each an undivided one-half interest; to provide for the charge and collection of tolls on said bridges and the application of such tolls on the purchase price of the interstate highway bridge and approaches over the Potomac River at Brunswick, Maryland, until such purchase price shall be paid in full, and to make both such bridges and approaches thereafter free of tolls; to provide for the payment of one-half of the cost of repair, operation and maintenance of the said bridges from funds appropriated for the maintenance of roads and bridges in the State highway system.

CHAPTER 388.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 39 of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1888 Edition), title "Allegany County," sub-title "County Treasurer," as said section was amended by Chapter 115 of the Acts of 1910, the new amendments to allow the County Treasurer to succeed himself in office.
