bonds, and to acquire the title of the said lands in the name of the Board of Education for Talbot County.

SEC. 9. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect from or after the first day of June, 1929.

CHAPTER 479.

- AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 417 of Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Washington County," sub-title "Williamsport," as amended by Chapter 17 of the Acts of 1904, eliminating the provision relative to lockup and the levying of additional taxes.
- Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 417 of Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Washington County," sub-title "Williamsport," as amended by Chapter 17 of the Acts of 1904, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments to read as follows:
- 417. If at any time the said Burgess and Commissioners deem it advisable, they are authorized and empowered to establish and maintain a fire department for the said town.
- Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1929.

CHAPTER 480.

AN ACT to add two new sections to Article 39 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Fish and Fisheries," to be known as Sections 67A and 67B, and to follow Section 67, prohibiting the use of any sunken anchored gill nets at all times, and prohibiting the use of any gill nets known as floating or drift nets and stake gill nets
