

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 348 of Article 23 of Bagby's Annotated Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, 1924 edition, entitled "Corporations," sub-title "Public Service Commission," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

Section 348. The term Common Carrier when used in this sub-title shall likewise include all bridges now or hereafter erected by any corporation authorized to charge and collect toll from persons using the same as foot passengers and for vehicular traffic of every kind.

CHAPTER 483.

AN ACT to repeal Section 66 of Article 101 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Workmen's Compensation," sub-title "Miscellaneous," said section relating to appropriations to State Industrial Accident Commission.

WHEREAS, Since the adoption of the Budget Amendment, sections of the Code providing for specific appropriations to the several departments are useless and superfluous; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 66 of Article 101 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, (1924 Edition), title "Workmen's Compensation," sub-title "Miscellaneous," be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1929.
