Whereas, Since the adoption of the Budget Amendment, sections of the Code providing for specific appropriations to the several departments are useless and superfluous; therefore

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 26, 29 and 30 of Article 39A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Forestry," subtitles "Roadside Trees" and "Miscellaneous," be and they are hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1929.

AN ACT to repeal Section 11 of Article 13 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Bills of Exchange and Promissory Notes."

Whereas, Section 11 of Article 13 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), is a duplicate of Section 18 of Article 75 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Pleadings, Practice and Process at Law," sub-title "Pleadings"; therefore

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 11 of Article 13 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Bills of Exchange and Promissory Notes," be and it is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1929.
