

pertaining to the subject of land laws and descent and of the rights of heirs and devisees.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the commission to prepare a report containing drafts of one or more bills revising the inheritance laws of the State of Maryland, together with any recommendations or comments as to same. The said report shall be submitted by the commission to the Governor not later than December 1, 1930, and shall be submitted by the Governor to the General Assembly.

SEC. 4. *And be it further enacted*, That the expenses of the commission shall be defrayed out of such funds as may be provided for in the budget or otherwise.

SEC. 5. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1929.

CHAPTER 528.

AN ACT to repeal Section 25 of Article 26 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Courts," sub-title "Judgments."

WHEREAS, Section 25 of Article 26 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), is a duplicate of Section 87 of Article 16 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Chancery," sub-title "Injunction"; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 25 of Article 26 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Courts," sub-title "Judgments," be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1929.
