## CHAPTER 555.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 7 and 11 of Article 66A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Edition of 1924, title "Motion Pictures," by conferring additional powers and duties upon the Maryland State Board of Censors, and for providing a new schedule of fees chargeable by said Board.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 7 and 11 of Article 66A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Edition of 1924, title "Motion Pictures," be, and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, so as to read as follows:

7. Upon each film which has been approved by the Board, there shall be furnished by the Board, the following certificate or statement: "Approved by the Maryland State Board of Censors No. . . . .," and the Board shall also furnish a certificate or license in writing to the same effect, which certificate shall be the license for such film unless and until the same shall be revoked by said Board, and said certificate or license shall be exhibited by the holder thereof to any member of the
