I, DAVID C. WINEBRENNER, 3D, SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, pursuant to the direction contained in Chap. 441 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Md. of 1922, Do Hereby Certify, That at the General election held in this State on Tuesday, November 6, 1928, an Act, known as Chapter 264 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1927, was submitted to the voters of Somerset County for their adoption or rejection, under the provisions of Article 16 of the Constitution of the State, said Act being:

An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments Sections 238 and 239 of Article 20 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Somerset County," sub-title "Revenue and Taxes," as said Section 238 was amended by Chapter 10 of the Acts of 1910 and as said Section 239 was amended by Chapter 105 of the Acts of 1922, increasing the salary of the Treasurer and Deputy Treasurer of Somerset County.

AND I Do CERTIFY, That at said election 292 votes were cast in favor of the adoption of said Chapter 264 of the Acts of 1927, and 2,084 votes were cast against the adoption of said Act, in Somerset County; and a majority being against the adoption thereof, it was thereby rejected and repealed by the voters.
