I, DAVID C. WINEBRENNER, 3D, SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, pursuant to the direction contained in Chap. 441 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Md. of 1922, Do Hereby Certify, That at the General election held in this State on Tuesday, November 6, 1928, an Act, known as Chapter 231 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1927, was submitted to the voters of Anne Arundel County for their adoption or rejection, under the provisions of Article 16 of the Constitution of the State, said Act being:

An Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel County to appoint two discreet persons to be building inspectors and to give permits for the construction and repair of buildings in said county, and providing for their duties, powers and compensations.

And I Do Certify, That at said election 1,287 votes were cast in favor of the adoption of said Chapter 231 of the Acts of 1927, and 7,509 votes were cast against the adoption of said Act, in Anne Arundel County; and a majority being against the adoption thereof, it was thereby rejected and repealed by the voters.
