*To the Clerk of the Court of Appeals:*

I, DAVID C. WINEBRENNER, 3D, SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, pursuant to the direction contained in Chap. 441 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Md. of 1922, Do **HEREBY CERTIFY**, That at the General election held in this State on Tuesday, November 6, 1928, an Act, known as Chapter 392 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1927, was submitted to the voters of Anne Arundel County for their adoption or rejection, under the provisions of Article 16 of the Constitution of the State, said Act being:

An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 3 of Article 33 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Elections," sub-title "Supervisors of Elections," increasing the salaries of Supervisors of Elections in Anne Arundel County to Four Hundred Dollars (\$400), each per annum.

AND I Do CERTIFY, That at said election 1,266 votes were cast in favor of the adoption of said Chapter 392 of the Acts of 1927, and 7,419 votes were cast against the adoption of said Act, in Anne Arundel County; and a majority being against the adoption thereof, it was thereby rejected and repealed by the voters.
