The appropriation for 1930 to Baltimore City, to be paid from Special Funds shown on page 79 of the Budget Bill, will be changed to \$1,085,757 and in 1931 to \$1,108,999.

The appropriation for 1930 to the State Roads Commission, to be paid from Special Funds shown on page 63 of the Budget Bill, for maintenance and reconstruction of State and State-aided roads, will be changed to \$4,343,031 and in 1931 to \$4,435,998.
