Sec. 6. And be it further enacted, That the said Commissioners of Aberdeen be and they are hereby authorized to acquire and own in its own name for the benefit of said municipal corporation the land within the limits of said Town of Aberdeen on which to construct and maintain the building aforesaid, and to use so much of the proceeds of said bonds as may be necessary for that purpose.

Sec. 7. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect from and after the first day of June, 1929.

AN ACT to repeal Section 101 of Article 43 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Health," sub-title "Tuberculosis."

CHAPTER 241.

AN ACT to repeal Section 532 of Article 27 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Crimes and Punishments, sub-title "Wages—Payment of by Certain Corporations."

Whereas, Section 532 of Article 27 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), is a duplicate of Section 151 of Article 23 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Corporations," sub-title "Miscellaneous Provisions"; therefore

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 532 of Article 27 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1924 Edition), title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Wages—Payment of by Certain Corporations," be and it is hereby repealed.
