INTRODUCTION OF BILLS.

Senate Bill No. 11—By Senator Lindsay (President):

A Bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 17 of Article 77 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title 'Public Education', sub-title 'Chapter 3.
