

MESSAGE TO THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES

By Senator Sothoron:

Gentlemen of the House of Delegates:

We have received your message notifying the Senate of the organization of your Honorable Body, and proposing the appointment of a joint committee of five members, three to be appointed upon the part of the House and two upon the part of the Senate, to wait upon the Governor and inform him that the General Assembly is now prepared to receive any communication which he may desire to make.
